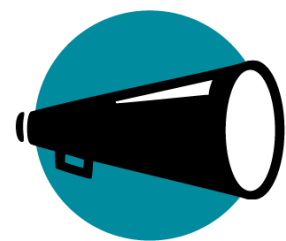
In this session, we will engage with diverse thought leaders from a variety of fields that will spark dialogue about the past, present, and future to keep moving forward.
